# Ebenezer Youth apprenticeship (level one)

The Ebenezer Youth apprenticeship level one exists for those to have an inside view of what ministry looks like in an apprentice-type role and to discern whether or not your vocational calling may be in Christian Ministry with this apprenticeship specifically focused on Youth Ministry.

### How this is apprenticeship going to be done?

#### 1. You will be invested into

- You will grow in three primary areas, 1. Character formation, 2. Theological formation, 3. Ministry formation
  - We will focus primarily on what it means to be a follower of Jesus in the context of full-time ministry
  - You will grow in your theological thinking by working through complex subjects in a practical way
  - You will be invested into on a practical level in growing your ministry skills and abilities
  - There will also be an intentional investment in your personal spiritual growth. We will be walking alongside each other in discipleship intentionally in various ways

#### 2. You will learn what it means to be in ministry

- You will get an inside view of what ministry looks like from a pastoral perspective
- You will have opportunities to lead in the ministry through the training you will receive

## What your week may typically look like

- Weekly meeting apprentice with Youth Pastor (2 hours)
- Tri-weekly one on one meeting with Youth Pastor (1 hour)
- Jr youth night (3 hours)



- Sr youth night (3 hours)
- Speaking, programming, vision, administrative tasks, etc. (0-2 hours)
- Making intentional connections with the youth (1–3 hours)
- Other things that 'come up' (O-1 hours)
- = 10-15 hours

- 3. Sustainable Youth Ministry, by Mark DeVries

#### The length of the apprenticeship

The length we are asking for you to commit for the apprenticeship to is eight months long, (September 1- May 1). But this can be negotiated and extended throughout the summer upon further discussion (also keep in mind your commitment as a youth life group leader if you are doing that as well).
