Qualifications for one to be a leader at Ebenezer Youth:

- Leader must be a follower of Jesus
- Lead call's Ebenezer Baptist Church your church family (if from another church please reach out to chat about what youth leadership could mean)
- Leaders must be able to sign off on our church denominations statement of faith, marriage statement, and read, agree, and live up too a youth leaders conduct code (a lifestyle agreement)

Process of Application for a leader at Ebenezer Youth:

- Read the documents below (Comprehensive guide to youth leadership, various leadership roles)
- Fill out the Ebenezer Youth Leadership application
- -Interview with the Jr/Sr Youth Pastor
- Give two references (one within the church, and one outside of the church)
- Sign off on Ebenezer Youth Leaders Code of Conduct, BGC Statement of Faith, and BGC Marriage Statement
- Do a Criminal Record Check and a Vulnerable Sector Check every 2 years
- Complete Because We Care training yearly

Ongoing development for a leader at Ebenezer Youth:

- Bi-weekly check in-ins/ coaching from youth pastor
- Annual leaders retreat to train in their leadership and ensure our leaders complete because we care training annually
- YWC annual winter conference, our core team at Ebenezer Youth will be going to the YWC conference
- Annual winter training before the winter kicks off
- Meetings every three months to check in as a large leader group to see how things are going






