

Ebenezer Youth L.I.T's

An L.I.T is someone who is a leader in training. You are reading this because you may be someone who has leadership potential.

Three things that being an L.I.T means:

- 1. You will be developed as a leader with Ebenezer Youth
- 2. You will have opportunities to lead at Ebenezer Youth
- 3. Most importantly, we will dive deeper into following Jesus together

The three core values of being an L.I.T at Ebenezer Youth:

- 1. Relationship in God
- 2. Humility
- 3. Servanthood

Commitment time:

- Tuesdays 6:45-9:15pm
- Yearly L.I.T retreat

How will we serve in the year?:

For an L.I.T level one:

1. Serving in different areas of Jr youth regularly
 - Welcome team
 - Leading activity
 - Prayer/ announcements
 - Sharing testimony (both Jr/Sr youth night)
 - Sharing devotional
 - Thinking creatively and giving some thought into how we run youth (Jr/Sr youth night)
2. Helping out with children's ministry
3. Helping out on Sundays in various capacities



For an L.I.T level two:

1. Jr youth life group leader (Only for grade 11-12's)
2. Helping out on Sundays in various capacities

When will we meet as L.I.T's?**L.I.T level ones:**

L.I.T level ones will meet together during the teaching time at Jr youth and at life group time (approximately 1 hour long). This is what we will do during this time:

- Dig into the bible together
- Work through leadership content together
- Do life with each other, pray for each other!
- Talk about what's coming in the week
- Give responsibilities to each L.I.T for the next week

L.I.T level twos:

L.I.T level twos will meet together before Sr youth at **5:30–6:30pm on**

Wednesdays. Here is what L.I.T level twos will do:

- Debrief life groups with Jr youth kids the night before
- Dig into the bible together
- Work through leadership content together
- Do life with each other, pray for each other!

What is the commitment level of an L.I.T?:

If you want to become an L.I.T we ask your commitment level to being an L.I.T would be on the top of your list. If you are unable to make 50% percent of being at Tuesday nights for whatever reason, it may be best to not be an L.I.T.

How old do I have to be to be an L.I.T?

You have to be in Grade 9–12 to be an L.I.T.

How do I apply to be an L.I.T?

We see L.I.T'ing in two semesters and camp leadership training:

Semester 1: September 1–December 15

Semester 2: January 10–May 17

Camp leadership training: May 24–June 21

The areas you must apply to are the two semesters of L.I.Ting. All who are planned to serve at camp are invited to camp leadership training. For any of the two semesters of L.I.Ting and you will have to fill our our L.I.T application form in the next page:

Qualifications to Apply:

- You are in Grades 9–12.
- You are a believe and follow Jesus.
- You are desiring to grow in your relationship with Jesus and your leadership abilities.
- You have read the Baptist General Conference Statement of Faith and understand that it is the basis of what is taught at Ebenezer Baptist Church

Expectations:

- You must attend an L.I.T training weekend
- You are committed to showing up on time and staying until the evening is done (6:45–9:15pm) and are ready to participate in all portions of our night together.
- You are willing to communicate appropriately if you will be absent for a program night. We expect ONE WEEK notice when possible, and that you attend at least 50% of the time.

Application:
